# PAR TAX \$ Update– Town Square Park

The first project with the recently passed November 2018 PAR Tax (Sales Tax) was the renovation of what was called Pink School Park, to now be known as Town Square Park. The focus was on:

- 1) Securing chain link fencing along 200 N. to protect park participants.
- 2) Purchasing 8 light poles from Musco Lighting.
- 3) Trenching electrical lines and installing light poles. Replacing sod.
- 4) Striping parking lines on two sides of the park.
- 5) Build retaining wall to enlarge west field to full size field. Replacing sod.
- 6) Coming Soon! Wrought Iron fence between west field and ambulance building.
- 7) Coming Soon! Installation of 2 large scoreboards



A field grand opening was scheduled for April 21. Spring Soccer was kicked off in Nephi with over 200+ youth participants. Other than the wet Spring, the season went well. Donors for the fields included: \$5,500 Utah Youth Soccer Association, \$5,000 Real Salt Lake, \$5,000 Cache Valley Bank

## **Lifetime Liability Waiver**

Nephi is using a "Lifetime Liability Waiver". To participate in Recreation programs you must have a **current** waiver. This will be kept at the Recreation Office.

\*This family waiver is valid for all family members under the age of 18.

\*This allows families to continue to register youth without having to repeatedly fill out .

\*The family waiver must be filled out by a parent or guardian.

Participants that are 18 years or older should fill out their own waiver specific to the sport or program in which they are participating. Completed waivers are available:

## **Refund Policy**

- 1)-Nephi Recreation will offer a refund for Youth & Adult Sports/Classes if requested before the last day of registration. A full refund will be given minus \$5 processing fee or a 100% refund will be credited to a participants' online Recreation account.
- 2)-Once a sport/class is in process (any time after registration ends) no refund will be given. In cases of season ending illness or injury, refunds may be considered with a doctor's note by the Recreation Director.
- 3)-All other situations will be reviewed on a case by case situation.
