Cardboard Boat Regatta Rules

Boat Design & Construction

1. Boats must be made BEFORE the race. Judges can inspect the boats for design violations and vote on the "most creative" design for each age division.
2. Boats should only be made of cardboard and duct tape, with NO reinforced cardboard tubes allowed.
3. Duct tape can be varying colors, but they must have been manufactured as that color. No markers, paint or crayon coloring.
4. Boats may be a maximum width of 60" (5 ft.) and a maximum length of 84" (7 ft.). There is no maximum height requirement.
5. Boats must be completely enclosed, or permit the crew to remain fully on top of the boat (without allowing their extremities to dangle in the water).
6. Homemade hand-paddles made of duct tape and cardboard are allowed to paddle. The other option is to use your hands.

Racing Format

1. Boats should be designed to race with a two-person crew for 50 meters (down and back).
2. Wearing personal flotation device is optional due to the narrow swimming pool.
3. The teammate in the rear of the boat may push the boat away from the side of the pool at the beginning of the race, as well as during the halfway checkpoint. However, during the race, both teammates *inside* the boat may NOT use lane lines, the sides of the pool, or other boats to help propel their own boat.
4. The boat that travels the 50 meters with the fastest time will win.
5. Maximum 2 people per team.
6. Depending on how many boats there are, multiple heats will be held with 3 boats per heat in each age division. The fastest boats from each heat in each age division will participate in a final race to crown the fastest boat overall.
